Just as operators have to be trained on how to operate a lift truck, pedestrians need to know how to navigate where lift trucks are being used.

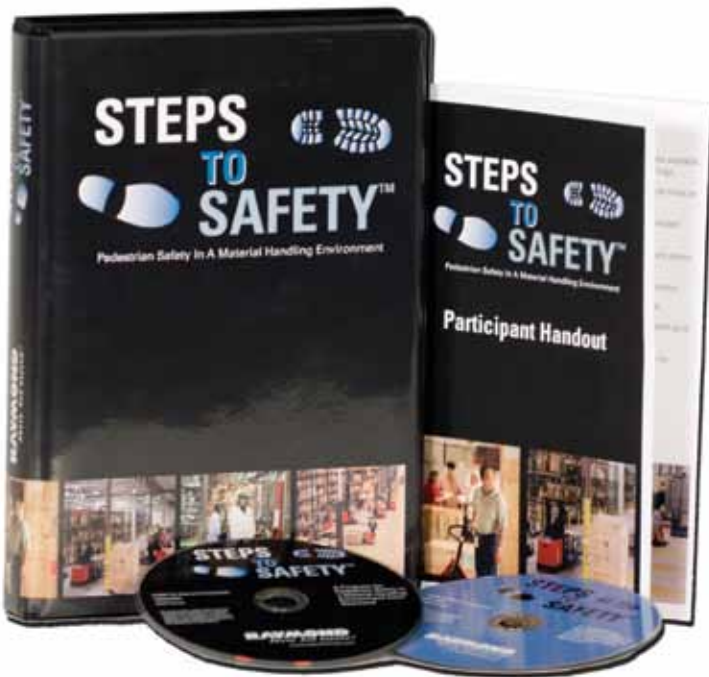
